NIUE TRAVEL ADVISORY #10 2021
COVID-19 (NOVEL CORONAVIRUS)

1st March 2021

No.10

Niue's borders are currently closed to all travelers unless:

- a) there is an exemption provided (in writing) by the Chief Immigration Officer, and
- b) each traveler has spent at least 14 days in New Zealand prior to entry into Niue.

Passenger flights to Niue from Auckland are operated by Air New Zealand every fortnight. There is a maximum number of 30 passengers permitted to enter Niue per flight.

Entry to ALL yachts, cruise ships, and other sea vessels is **NOT** permitted with an exception to freight vessels, and vessels in emergency and distress.

Entry criteria into Niue, subject to approval:

- a) Niue's returning residents and students,
- b) Niue work or resident permit holders
- c) Niueans or Niue descendants
- d) Essential workers, ie Diplomats, skilled workers and special cases such as the immediate family of members of residents and those travelling under urgent or emergency circumstances

Medical criteria into Niue (Public Health Act 1965)

All travelers:

- a) must register their intention to travel to Niue through the Office of the Secretary to Government on email Niue.SecGov@mail.gov.nu and upon approval, comply with the guidelines provided, and
- b) will be required to undergo 14 days quarantine at a designated location approved by Cabinet upon arrival in Niue, and
- c) must provide one (1) negative COVID-19 test within 4 working days prior to departure from Auckland, New Zealand.

Please note this Travel Advisory is subject to be reviewed and amended as required.
